



A NEW WAY TO RECEIVE YOUR WORKERS' COMPENSATION PAYMENTS


You can now choose to receive your Workers' Compensation payments in one of three ways – **by direct deposit, by the Pennsylvania Chase MasterCard® debit card, or by paper checks.** The payment method you select will be in effect for all your future payments.

What is Direct Deposit?

Direct deposit – As the claimant, you authorize the State Workers' Insurance Fund to deposit your payments directly into your bank account (checking or savings).

What is the Pennsylvania Chase MasterCard® Debit Card?

Pennsylvania Chase Debit MasterCard® - The Pennsylvania Chase MasterCard® debit card is designed for the convenience of receiving electronic payments and a new option if you do not have a bank account. As an eligible claimant for benefits, you authorize the State Workers' Insurance Fund to post your payments to your Pennsylvania Chase MasterCard® debit card with which you can withdraw cash and make purchases against the amount of your card.
