## What Is Money Match?

Money Match is a new way for the Pennsylvania Treasury Department to return unclaimed property to its rightful owners! It's a law that the General Assembly supported *unanimously*, and it was signed into law by the Governor.

## What Is Unclaimed Property?

Unclaimed property can be old bank accounts, uncashed paychecks, insurance payments, rebates – the list is virtually endless. The bottom line is that it's money owed to people just like you. More than 1 in 10 Pennsylvanians has unclaimed property available to be claimed!

## Why Did I Get This Letter?

Because you have unclaimed property! In other words, the state owes you money.

## What Do I Have to Do?

Nothing! We've already confirmed that this money belongs to you. Now that you've received this letter, we'll send a check to you at this address in about 45 days.



## This Seems Too Good to Be True!

We understand. The idea that the state government wants to give you money is different. But thanks to a lot of incredible bipartisan work involving Treasurer Garrity, the entire General Assembly and the Governor, this is really happening!
